Course Description:

This course offers a concise overview of Confined Spaces and Permit-Required Confined Spaces (PRCS), highlighting their importance in workplace safety and OSHA compliance. Participants will explore the unique risks associated with these environments and learn best practices for ensuring safe operations in a variety of workplace settings.
