MIOSHA Safety and Health Program Essentials: Building a Safer Workplace

Course Description:

The Recommended Practices for Safety and Health Programs provides a flexible, evidence-based framework for improving workplace safety across a wide range of industries. It is designed for responsible employers, workers, and worker representatives who want to strengthen their organization's safety culture and reduce injuries, illnesses, and compliance risks. It emphasizes management leadership, worker participation, hazard identification, hazard prevention, training, working with contractors, and program evaluation.

Participants will be able to:

- Explain how each employer is to protect their workers who are using a SHMS in their workplace.
- Apply the uses of a SHMS to detect hazards to real-world scenarios to determine employer responsibilities and appropriate actions for hazard elimination.
- Demonstrate understanding of effective communication and coordination among users of a SHMS that will lead employers to take action towards worker protection.

Presenter:

Chris Johnson is an Occupational Safety Consultant with the Consultation Education and Training Division of MIOSHA. Chris currently provides consultation and training services for Southwest Michigan counties.
